The majority of premature or ill newborns begin receiving enteral feedings via gavage tube while in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU). Prior to discharge, an infant should be taking a prescribed volume by mouth while maintaining an adequate weight gain pattern and stable cardio-respiratory status.
